## ABHAYESWARI H.S. & M.P. SCHOOL - AT A GLANCE

Long past in the year 1904, Abhayeswari H.E. School took its birth at Abhayapuri town under the patronage of her highness the late queen Abhayeswari of the then Bijni Raj Estate. Within a few span of time, this school was able to achieve the recognition & appreciation from the Calcutta University. In the year 1956, when the town was under the management of the then Bijni Raj Estate government, some of indigenous people put their demand to make this school a purely government school. But ultimately the school was placed under

deficit system of grant in Aid by the Education

department of Assam w.e.f. 01-03-1959 and also at the same time a development committee was formed for the management of the school. In 1962 this school was upgraded to the status of Higher Secondary school and the school was renamed as Abhayeswari Higher Secondary and Multipurpose school by introducing two streams, i.e. Science and Arts. The school was also benefitted with the Vocational Stream in the



higher secondary section in 1989 which offered two course trades as Computer Technique and Accountancy & Auditing. This school got provincialised accordingly in 1977. In the year 2015, the department of secondary education, Assam has introduced two new subjects - Information Technology and Retail Trade for Class IX and now it has been upgraded to higher secondary standard.

The school crossed the line of hundred years in the year 2004. During this long journey of the school in the field of education, the institution has succeeded in bringing glory and fame in various state and district level performances by the students of the school. Time and again, students from this school have brought enormous pride to this institution by excelling in academics and have been flourishing in their respected field of work in India and abroad.

## PROCEDURE OF ADMISSION :

Candidates are required to submit photostate copies of the following documents along with the application form :

- ◆ 3 copies of recent coloured passport size photograph.
- ◆ Mark sheet of the HSLC examination.
- ◆ Testimonials from the Principal/Headmaster of the school last attended.
- ◆ Admit card of the last qualifying examination (for age proof)
- ◆ HSLC pass certificate issued by SEBA/CBSE etc.
- ◆ Migration Certificate should be produced for other state board/CBSE etc.
- ◆ Caste certificate
- ◆ BPL card (if any)
- ◆ For free admission, students have to submit Income Certificate having below 1 lakh from the concerned authority.

N.B. : The above documents/certificates are required to be produced in original at the time of admission.

## RULES AND REGULATIONS :

- ◆ In the school campus, the students must give respect to the teachers and their seniors and love to their juniors and must abide by the rules and regulations of the school.
  - ◆ Students will keep the class rooms and school premises absolutely clean, thus promoting clean environment.

- Students are expected to take part in all the co-curricular activities of the school as part of the civic, cultural training.
- ◆ Every students is expected to keep up the high tone of the school excelling in conduct and good manners in and out of the school.
  - ◆ Consumption of tobacco and promoting Ragging is strictly prohibited within the school premises.

## DISMISSAL :

Irregular attendance, non payment of fees, habitual disobedience and indiscipline, which is injurious to the moral, lead to the dismissal of a student at any time of the year.

Any misbehavior of a serious nature that has become public knowledge either inside or outside the campus is liable to bring about suspension/dismissal from the school.

## AFFILIATION AND SYLLABUS :

The school affiliated to SEBA and AHSEC respectively for High School Leaving Certificate and Higher Secondary and is following the examination process of SEBA and AHSEC. The syllabus and evaluation will be followed as prescribed by the SEBA for class IX and X and for class 10+2, the syllabus and evaluation process is followed as prescribed by the AHSEC.

## COURSES :

The school provides High school level courses from class VI to Class X and Higher secondary level courses with ARTS, SCIENCE and VOCATIONAL streams. Moreover two additional core subjects INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY AND RETAIL TRADE are providing for class IX to class XII.

**TRADE & SUBJECTS OFFERED FOR VOCATIONAL STREAM :**

English (Core), MIL (Assamese)/Alternative English(Core), Computer Technique OR Accountancy & Auditing, \*\* Environmental Education (Core) for HS 1st yr.

**ATTENDANCE :**

A student must attend at least 80% of classes held failing which he/she shall be debarred from appearing in the final examination. If any student remains absent for any purpose, he/she must submit application with guardian's signature to the Principal of the school. Continuous absence for illness, requires certificate from the concerned authority.

**EXTRACURRICULAR ACTIVITIES :**

Along with the academic session, the students are provided to develop their leadership qualities and talents by various activities like plantation, Games & Sports, Music, Seminar, Quiz, Debate, Science Modeling etc. The school gives sufficient importance to sports , games, cultural & scientific innovative activities to bring out the best in our students.

**FACILITIES :**

- ◆ Well setup school ground for football, volleyball / Cricket / Table Tennis.
- ◆ Modern water filtering system is installed to give safe drinking water.
- ◆ Well equipped and furnished library with sufficient number of books on different subjects for the use of students.
- ◆ Well equipped Physics, Chemistry and Biology laboratory for Science stream, three separate Computer laboratories for Vocational Stream, IT/ITes & Rajeev Gandhi Computer Saksharta Abhiyan (RGCSA), one Retail Trade Subject Laboratory exists in the school.
- ◆ Seminars and Science innovative model making are conducted time to time by the students guided by concerned teachers.
- ◆ CCTV cameras installed in different places including class rooms in the school to ensure safety and discipline.
- ◆ Educational Excursion/Tour/Field study is organized by the concerned departments of the school every year.

Identity card is issued to every student and they have to bring it every day while coming to the school.
